

1		<b>Calm at Sunset</b> [Hartland Sunset]	<b>Francis Bryan</b>	Tremendous image, plenty of atmosphere and works well. <b>Best image in the competition.</b>
2		<b>Approaching Storm</b> [Burnham on Sea Lighthouse]	<b>Alastair Lofthouse LRPS</b>	Liked the side lighting that picked out the lighthouse. Well exposed with use of appropriate shutter speed. Strong image.
3		<b>Riding the Waves</b> [Riding the Waves]	<b>Allan Paice</b>	Excellent action shot with just the right amount of movement in the waves.
4		<b>Storm Force</b> [Storm Force]	<b>Jim Munday CPAGB AFIAP BPE2</b>	Considered the weakest in the set. Didn't think it had the sharpness of the other images.
5		<b>Wipe Out</b> [Gales and High Tide, Newhaven]	<b>Fred Oudkerk</b>	A very strong image, enjoyed the strength of the waves and that the lighthouse can just be seen through the spray.

**Judges comment on the set:** Didn't like the sequence, he would have put "Calm at Sunset" in the middle: Clearly he hadn't taken note off the title of the set "Calm before the Storm"
