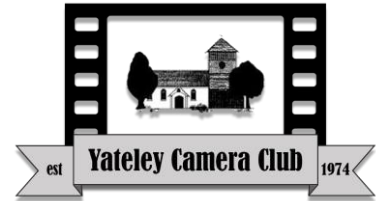

Occasionally meets different days or times, depending on the activity

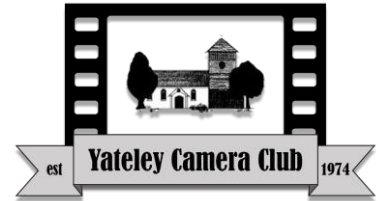
BRING YOUR CAMERA
