No	Image	Title	Photographer	Score	Judge's Comments
1		Scotney Castle Reflection	Chris Cranford	7.0	An artistic interpretation using just the reflections of the castle, which are nicely broken up by the ripples. The base of the image is the brightest part of the image so tends to draw one's eye down and out of the image. Would have been a better competition image with the suggested more uniform brightness balance.
2		The Blue Room	Brian Howe	10.0	An excellent image, both in its concept and rendition. Liked the textures within the image and the way the light, both direct and reflected interacted with the elements within the image. Didn't like the heavy white boarder, but he didn't deduct marks for that. Some judges would!! The best individual image.
3		Station Approach	Richard Wheeler	6.0	A factual record shot of a steam train entering a station. The sky and platform are over bright, and there is no sense of drama. As presented, its not a competition image, although there are elements within the image that could possibly make such an image, such as the faces in the window.
4		Law Court Interior, Spain	Vic Payne	8.5	High technical competency, with the details very crisp and precise. Liked the symmetry and exposure control. Overall a strong image.
5		You're a gonna my friend	Sue Roberts	7.5	Unusual positioning of the two animals, which are well captured, with crisp detail. However the seed heads in the foreground are a bit messy. Uncertain about the lighting around the animals.
6		The joys of autumn	Kerry Dutton	7.5	A reasonably competent still life, with a fairly central layout. Nicely lit, although possible too strong on the white pumpkin. Questioned the composition, felt there were too many elements. Suggested less is often better. Noted creases in the background that should have been ironed out.
7		What do you mean I'm going bald	Shareen Downe	7.0	Suggested that comic title was inappropriate. Also picked up on some strange colours above the head. As a portrait, suggested that eyes could have been higher in the frame, more on the upper third, which would have strengthen the image.
8		Light on the Fells Buttermere	John Jenkins	7.0	Interesting lighting conditions, with the light falling on the fells setting of the pines well. However, felt that the bright base pulled ones eyes down and out of the image.
